

# KALAMAZOO INSTITUTE OF ARTS

May 25 – September 2, 2018

The work of West Michigan's talented community of visual artists is on display at the Kalamazoo Institute of Arts' annual *West Michigan Area Show*. Since the 1960s, this annual juried exhibition has showcased exceptional work in all media, drawing hundreds of entries from a 14-county region. Each year, an experienced juror chooses the artists from more than 500 submitted entries, ranging from paintings, prints and photos to mosaics, ceramics, jewelry, sculpture and mixed-media works.

**Eligibility:** All artists 18 years or older residing in the following Michigan counties: Allegan, Barry, Berrien, Branch, Calhoun, Cass, Eaton, Ionia, Kalamazoo, Kent, Muskegon, Ottawa, St. Joseph, and Van Buren.

Only original work of the artist's own design, completed within the last 2 years should be entered. Digital media, 2-D, and 3-D works in any medium will be accepted. Work may not exceed six feet (72") on any side. Work must be on view the entire duration of the exhibition—no late delivery or early release. The KIA reserves the right to refuse any work that is inappropriate, framed inadequately, or misrepresented by entry image. Art quilts must be free-hanging (unframed), fabric-based, original compositions formed by stitched layers, and up to 90"h x 72"w. Works eligible for Glass Award may combine materials & techniques, but must be at least 50% glass. Portage Award requirements are online.
